## **Heat Stress**

Now that we are able to be outdoors more, we need to take precautions to avoid heat stress. Exposure to heat at 90 Fahrenheit and above can result in illnesses such as rashes, cramps, fatigue, strokes and even death. No matter what your reason for being outside, at work or at play, use the following precautions to prevent heat-related illnesses.

- Drink plenty of water before, after and during any physical activity. Water is the best fluid replenisher. Be aware that alcohol and beverages with caffeine (colas, ice teas, coffee, etc) can be dehydrating. Even though you may not feel thirsty, your body needs fluids. If you wait until your thirsty, you're already dehydrated.
- Pay close attention to weather reports and if possible, adjust your schedule accordingly. Try to do the most strenuous activates in the early morning or evening when the temperatures are cooler.
- Wear light colored, loose, cotton clothing. The light color reflects the sun and the cotton allows for air circulation. Wearing a hat can help to keep you cool as well.
- Wear sunscreen of SPF 15 or above. If you are swimming or engaged in physical activity that causes you to perspire, apply sunscreen often and liberally to exposed skin.
- Take frequent breaks out of the sun in a shady or cool area if possible. This is a good time to drink fluids.

Learn to recognize the early symptoms of heat-related illnesses, including nausea and dizziness. If you experience any of these symptoms, get out of the heat immediately and seek medical attention if appropriate.

Remember, a few basic precautions can make summer heat bearable.

## Dealing with Stocking Your First Aid Kit



Whether you're planning a trip or enjoying summer activities close to home, be prepared by keeping your first aid kits well-stocked. Include items such as:

- adhesive tape
- antibiotic ointment
- bandages and gauze of assorted sizes, as well as a roll of gauze
- sunscreen (SPF of at least 15)
- scissors
- cotton swabs
- over the counter pain relievers (ibuprofen, aspirin)
- thermometer
- tweezers
- insect repellant
- emergency contacts and list of allergy and prescription medications

Don't forget to replace items after you use them and be sure the kit is out of reach of young children. Make a kit for home and the car, as well as with your camping supplies if necessary.

#### Positive Outlook = Better Health?

Do you generally expect that good things will happen? If so, you may have more than a positive outlook on life. The link between optimism and personal health is a growing interest among researchers and medical practitioners.

Some of the latest studies show that optimists:

- cope with adversity in healthier ways
- build stronger social relationships
- have less pain and fewer physical complaints
- are more resistant to infections
- have a lower risk of heart disease
- may live longer after receiving a cancer diagnosis

Although several studies have found that optimism can improve your health, more research is need to pinpoint exactly how and why.

Some experts suggest that optimism may be an aspect of resilience that helps reduce your health risks. Others say that having a positive outlook may held reduce our cortisol level. This stress hormone is tied to heart, metabolic and immune-related diseases, as well as type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure and depression.

Not present: Ryan Watzke, Kellie Hentges, Natasha Mortenson. Staff present: Pastor David Christenson.

Devotion: Pastor Dave gave a devotion about community followed by a prayer.

Pastor Dave presented the council with a written report and went through it. Currently there are 13 kids signed up for the lock-in.

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> It was moved by Barry and seconded by Randy to approve the minutes as printed. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Doug reported that the first 3 weeks of June were very good but the 4<sup>th</sup> week was not, even though that week had the most parishioners attending. The audit committee met last night. It was moved by Laurie and seconded by Al to borrow \$8000 from the New Wine fund to pay the upcoming insurance bill. Motion carried. #### **Committee Reports:**

- Mission & Evangelism: Church With Out Walls will be held on September 11th this year. The Synod has some ideas how to incorporate the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary into our day. The committee would also like to do a bible study series untitled "My Neighbor Is Muslim" this fall.
- Education & Youth Committee: Pastor Dave reported that they have started talking about Sunday school for this fall. They did not pass out bibles to the 2<sup>nd</sup> graders last year and are looking into finding a more age appropriate one for them. Typically, Confirmation falls on Reformation Sunday and Pastor Dave would like to have it the weekend before.

#### Old Business:

- Luther's Eatery: Sign-ups are good on Sunday. Need more people to sign up on Saturday. We will not be serving past 5:00 on Saturday
- Polka Fest: It will be held on Sunday, July 31 at 1:00 at Eastside Park, worship followed by a 2 hour concert. Doug will look into a tent for shade cover. Laurie and Jill will help Pastor Dave with promotion. The youth will sell beverages.

#### **New Business:**

- Common Cup: Sue will be retiring in August. The Executive Committees from First and Faith will get together to talk about the direction/future of Common Cup. Pay needs to be increased to the manager.
